Description

- The cleaning of this 1950's Portland stone building involved 20,000m² of nebulous water spray cleaning to remove urban grime and extensive bird fouling to the projecting string courses, columns and pilasters.
- 15,000 lineal meters of repointing was carried out to the stonework and 1,000 metal windows cleaned and revived, including the renewal of mastic sealants between the window frames and the stone reveals.
- To prevent future problems of bird pollution a system of sprung wire and stone coloured netting was introduced.
